1. Payday today. Been allong drought for a good many of us. The usual details of guard and police duty. Many out on pass to relieve the monotony of this life. Is this area dry, today had a big wind come up and it was just like a fog for awhile from the dust blowing. Some Areal
2. Announcement made at formation of EM today that this outfit alerted as of 0800 today. Rain this morning early and literally caught some of the boys with their tent sides up. No date is set for our leaving but is to be within 48 hours. PX rations today.
3. Expect to leave any time now. Details for loading the TAT stuff for the boat. Changed our Allied Currency in lire to the good old USA currency. Sure been a long time since have seen that stuff. Its anytime now.
4. Still waiting around but now its tommorrow for sure. Usual assorted rumors as to where. Sure is good to be leaving Italy at long last.
5. Boarding ship today. Its the Sea Owl a passenger-cargo ship holding 2000 soldiers Pacific bound. This will be our new home for a month or more. And now its time to bid "Arrivededici" to good old sunny Italy. May we never see you again.
